This is the first study in Canada where community members decided what is most important to understand to improve quality of care for childbearing families.

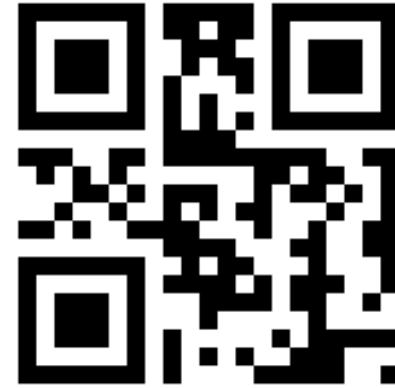
The RESPCCT study will collect information on the experience of childbearing care among people with diverse personal identities, circumstances, and backgrounds across Canada.
